Under my leadership, We Heart Seattle volunteers removed over a million pounds of hazardous trash and over 35,000 needles from parks and urban hiking trails to restore safe access for all.

Rent increases are getting out of control. Hard work deserves affordable housing. We need to look at creative solutions like social housing initiatives.



I am opposed to school closures. We must create more options in our schools to better prepare our kids for the future.



With property values climbing, I am concerned too many seniors are going to be forced out of their homes. I support expanding the senior property tax deferral.



I envision an equitable approach to public safety. We need to make sure our police officers treat everyone with respect and dignity with on-going training and oversight.



There are four overdose deaths per day in King County alone. Overdose deaths have quintupled in the past few years in the State of Washington. We cannot wait. The solution is a model of prevention, intervention, treatment, and recovery.
